NONRESIDENT TAXPAYER LIBRARY CARDS

A nonresident, who, as an individual or as a partner, principle stockholder, or other joint owner, owns taxable property or is a senior administrative officer of a firm, business, or other corporation owning taxable property within the district, is entitled to a nonresident taxpayer card provided that the privileges and use of the library is extended to only one such nonresident for each parcel of taxable property.

Nonresident taxpayer cards shall allow for full reciprocal borrowing privileges at all participating public libraries.

A patron shall use only their own nonresident taxpayer library card for any and all library transactions including but not limited to circulation functions, program registration and other library services.

Nonresident taxpayers will be issued a library card upon presentation of the most recent tax bill for the property, proof of eligibility from the categories listed and two pieces of personal identification, one of which must show a signature. If no signature appears on either of the first two pieces of identification, a third piece with a signature is also required.

Nonresident taxpayer library cards are issued for a period of one year and may be renewed upon verification of continued eligibility.

Lost cards will be replaced for a fee.
